These prices include the supply of a veneered oak coffin and the third party costs of a doctor's fee for the cremation certificate, crematorium charges and a funeral celebrant.

Optional extras to the above can include a limousine, order of service cards, webcasting, flowers and newspaper notices. These will be of your choosing and prices will gladly be given upon request.

For your peace of mind, our NAFD code of practice requires us to provide you with a bespoke estimate for your approval prior to the funeral taking place.

### Burial Costs P.O.A

These can vary considerably depending on the churchyard or cemetery chosen for same.
